Lakehurst Elementary School will hold its Spooktacular Prek – 3rd grade Halloween Parade on Friday, October 29. Our parade will take place outside, weather permitting. Please watch curbside, outside the playground fence on Pine, Lake, or Union Avenue. The students will parade around the perimeter of the playground fence.

PARADE SCHEDULE

All Prek Classes: 8:45 AM

Kindergarten, 1st, 2nd, 3rd: 9:30 AM

All students in grades Pre K – 8th are invited to wear age-appropriate Halloween costumes. Parents are asked to consider that some costumes may be inappropriate for an elementary school and that the goal for the day is to provide a safe and fun way to celebrate Halloween. It is strongly recommended that students wear costumes that are comfortable, as they will wear them all day. We kindly ask parents of Prek students to make sure they have a comfortable outfit on under their costumes. After the parade, Prek students will take their costumes off. All students must abide by the dress code, as listed in the Student Handbook.

Please be advised of the following guidelines for costumes:

- No weapons or items resembling weapons (guns, swords, hooks, nunchucks, axes, sickles, staffs, etc.)
- Masks are permitted to be worn during the parade only
- No undergarments should be showing or worn as an outer garment
- Costumes should be of appropriate fit
- Alcohol and tobacco advertisements and other inappropriate slogans or pictures are not permitted
- No “blood” make-up, props or special effects equipment

In case of inclement weather, the parade will be canceled and you will be informed via the REMIND app. Should you not want your child participating in any Halloween activities, please inform your child’s teacher in advance of October 28. The teacher will discuss all options for you that day. I would like to wish everyone a safe and Happy Halloween!
