Dear Parents and Guardians of Lakehurst Elementary School,

First and foremost, the administration and staff wish all of the students and families a very Happy New Year and hope you have enjoyed the holidays and winter break!

Yet again, we are handed another challenge due to the global pandemic and have been in frequent contact with the Ocean County Department of Health. We are experiencing high levels of positive COVID-19 cases within the school community, which will affect our schedule for the next couple of weeks, to ensure the safety and well-being of all individuals. Below are all of the details for the upcoming two weeks of remote learning:

**Monday, January 3, 2022:** District Closed

**Tuesday, January 4, 2022 -- Friday, January 14, 2022:** Remote Learning

**Tuesday, January 4, 2022:** DELAYED REMOTE OPENING for STUDENTS ONLY

- Chromebook pick-up will take place from 10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. at the Main Office Entrance. Students may log on to their Google Classroom once they receive their Chromebooks.

**Tuesday, January 11, 2022:** DELAYED REMOTE OPENING for STUDENTS ONLY

- Any live meets or lessons will begin at 10:00 a.m.

**Monday, January 17, 2022:** School Closed for Observance of Martin Luther King Jr.

**Tuesday, January 18, 2022:** Return to in-person learning. Lakehurst Elementary School will open following a regular schedule.

**PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING IMPORTANT INFORMATION:**

- If your child or a member of your immediate household was diagnosed with COVID-19 during the Winter Break, please be sure to contact the school nurse, Mrs. Hess.
- The 2 weeks gives ample time to work through the exposures and possible positive cases.
- While we wait for updated guidance from the New Jersey Department of Health for new CDC updates, we will continue to follow guidance that is currently in place. An individual who is COVID-19 positive must quarantine for 10 days. An unvaccinated close contact must receive a negative test result between days 5 and 7 of the quarantine AFTER the last known exposure or the household member has completed their 10 day quarantine AND be symptom-free to return on day 8 or quarantine for an additional 14 days without testing. A fully vaccinated, close contact does not need to quarantine, if they are symptom free.
- Breakfast and Lunch can be picked-up two times per week at the cafeteria windows, in the back of the school on Pine Street between 10:30 AM-1:30 PM on:
  - Tuesday, January 4 and Thursday, January 6, 2022
  - Monday, January 10 and Thursday, January 13, 2022
- Daily attendance for Remote Learning is critical. Students must log on to daily meets and classes, as well as complete assignments to receive credit for being present.
- If a chromebook becomes damaged or stops working, please email Ms. Silvestri at [ssilvestri@lakehurstschool.org](mailto:ssilvestri@lakehurstschool.org) ASAP.
- If your child does not have access to WIFI or internet capabilities within the home, please contact the school for assistance.
- While on a Remote Learning schedule, you may still reach the Main Office staff at 732-657-5741.
