Dear Parents/Guardians:

Lakehurst Elementary School will hold its annual Spooktacular PreK – 3<sup>rd</sup> grade Halloween Parade on **Thursday, October 31<sup>st</sup>**. Our parade will take place outside, weather permitting.

- **PreK Parade will begin at 9:00 AM.** Parents/guardians should line up on the sidewalk, outside the perimeter of the playground fence on Pine Street, Lake Street and Union Avenue. The parade route for Prek students will be the inside perimeter of the playground. They will enter the playground area from the tunnel, turn right and walk the fence line on Pine Street to Lake Street, and Union Avenue. At the beginning of the small playground, they will turn and head back to the tunnel to go back to class.
- **Grades K-3<sup>rd</sup> Parade will begin at 9:30 AM.** Parents/guardians, please watch curbside so the parade route is not blocked. The parade route will be the sidewalk perimeter of the school. Students in grades 4 through 5 will be invited to watch the parade from the grass area of the playground.

In the event we have inclement weather, the parade will be cancelled and you will be informed via our school website, [www.lakehurstschool.org](http://www.lakehurstschool.org) and REMIND by 8:30 AM, the morning of the parade.

PreK – 8<sup>th</sup> students are invited to wear age-appropriate Halloween costumes. All students must abide by the dress code (Student Handbook). It is strongly recommended that students wear clothes under their costumes, in the event they would like to take off their costume afterwards.

Please be advised of the following guidelines for costumes:

- No weapons or items resembling weapons (guns, swords, hooks, nun chucks, axes, sickles, staffs, etc.)
- Masks are permitted to be worn during the parade only
- No undergarments should be showing or worn as an outer garment
- Costumes should be of appropriate fit
- Alcohol and tobacco advertisements and other inappropriate slogans or pictures are not permitted
- No “blood” make-up, props or special effects equipment

Please inform your child’s teacher before October 29<sup>th</sup> if you prefer your child not participate. I would like to wish everyone a safe and Happy Halloween!
